

## **Directions**

**Directions to Two Rivers Park:** from I-70 take exit 116. Turn left onto 6th Street at the traffic light. Stay on 6th street for about 3 blocks. Turn left onto Devereux Road. You will cross over I-70, the park will be on your left. 740 Devereux Rd.

## **Route:**

The trail is a Rails to Trails-type project, which is built on the Aspen Branch of the historic Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad right-of-way corridor. Train operations in this corridor ceased in phases, between the 1960's and the mid-1990's. We will be riding on a portion of the 44 miles of continuous multi-use trail, completely protected from vehicular traffic, except at intersections. The route is on hard surface with roughly a 2% grade the entire way. The metric century portion of the ride has an approximately 1,500 foot elevation gain.

The ride starts in Two Rivers Park at the confluence of the Colorado and Roaring Fork Rivers. Much of the trail passes through woodlands above the Roaring Fork River. The trail meanders by pastures, cows, horses, and scenic ranch lands while surrounded by the majestic Rocky Mountains.

You'll finish back at Two Rivers Park for a delicious grilled chicken meal.
